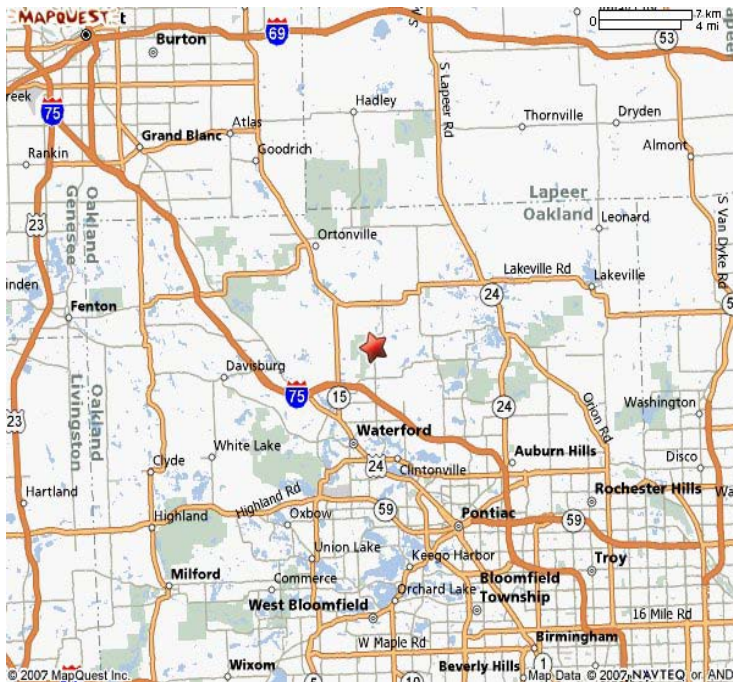

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

WHAT TO BRING:

- Each troop or group must supply the proper amount of adult leadership.
- Merit badge application (**blue card**) signed by your Scoutmaster
- **Your own food for the day.** Thirty minutes is scheduled as a lunch break.
- **Eye protection and head protection** (sunglasses and billed caps).

DRESS: BSA field or activity uniform, and weather appropriate dress. The class will be held rain or shine.

Scouts should obtain a copy of the Fly Fishing merit badge pamphlet and be prepared to discuss requirements 1, 7, 8, and 9 before arriving. Merit Badge Counselors will be on hand to certify each scout.
