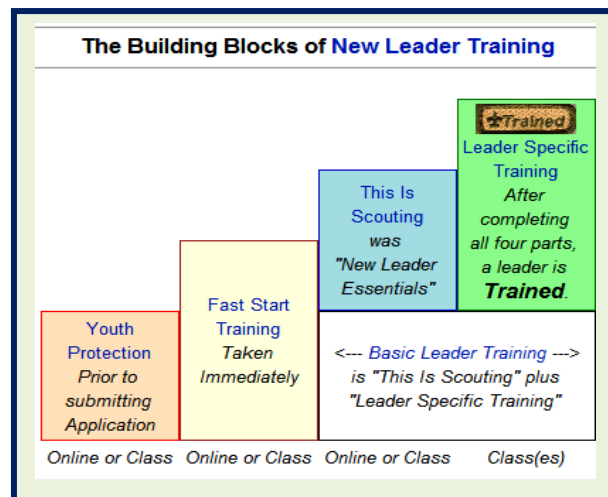
Camp Agawam, Morrison Shelter – Orion, Michigan
