**What:** BSA Training in Outdoor Skills developed to give new leaders the knowledge, skills, & current BSA policy information needed to be successful. You will meet other area leaders and our training staff who will share their experience and enthusiasm for the BSA programs.

**Who:** Scoutmasters, Assistant Scoutmasters and Varsity Scout Coaches

Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills is the required outdoor training for all Scoutmasters, assistant Scoutmasters, and Varsity Scout coaches. The skills taught are based on the outdoor skills found in *The Boy Scout Handbook*. The course is also ideal for Venturing leaders because it focuses on skills that build confidence and competence in leaders conducting outdoor camping experiences.

**When:** Friday, April the 27<sup>th</sup> till Sunday, April 29<sup>th</sup>.

(Registration starts at 6:30 p.m./course and ends around Noon on Sunday.)

**Where:** Camp D-BAR-A, The Pines training Facility – Metamora, Michigan

**Cost:** \$25.00 per participant with paid pre-registration mailed to the council service center in Waterford, MI. (register in person at either service center), Boy Scout and Scoutmaster Handbooks will be available for purchase on site.

**To qualify as Fully Trained & receive your "Trained" patch** confirm that you have completed the on-line sessions "This is Scouting", "Youth Protection Training" & position specific "Fast-Start". You must also complete the day long "Scoutmaster & Assistant SM Training Course"
