An additional highlight to the evening will be the presentation of the NESA Outstanding Eagle Scout Award (NOESA). This Award is a prestigious recognition granted by the local council’s NESA committee to Eagle Scouts who have demonstrated outstanding achievement at the local, state, or regional level. Awards will be presented to James Cambridge, Ken Czubay, Gordon Draper and Chuck Truza.

The Dinner will take place Wednesday evening, February 15, 2012, at the Suburban Collection Showplace, 46100 Grand River Ave, Novi, MI 48374.
