## ACHIEVEMENTS

More and more Scouting Units utilize popcorn sales to raise funds for equipment, activities and other needs. But that's not all! Few activities demonstrate the value of planning, organization and commitment more clearly than a Unit's efforts in a popcorn sale. Scouts develop and practice new skills, learn about sales and marketing, and reach new levels of personal success. **Your Scout's may be able to earn the requirements, electives, arrow points or Webelos activity badges listed here!**

## Tiger Cubs

REQUIREMENT 5F: As you gather at your show and sell locations, go outside and watch the weather.

ELECTIVE 2: Make decorations for your Unit Kickoff or show and sell display.

ELECTIVE 6: Song Time—sing a song at the Kickoff or while doing your show and sells.

ELECTIVE 7: Play Along— make a musical instrument and play it with others either at the Kickoff or while doing your show and sells.

ELECTIVE 9: A New Friend— help a new boy or girl get to know other people at your Kickoff or while doing your show and sells.

ELECTIVE 13: Making Change—learn to count coins and make change accurately while conducting your sales.

ELECTIVE 29: Safety in the Sun—talk with your adult partner about when you should use sunscreen. Just in case your show and sell locations are out in the sunshine.



## Wolf Cubs

REQUIREMENT 6a: Complete the Character Connection for Positive Attitude. Know, commit to and practice using a positive attitude while conducting your sale. This needs to be monitored by a Unit Leader.

REQUIREMENT 9a: Complete the Character Connection for Responsibility. Know, commit to and practice responsibility while conducting your popcorn sale. This needs to be monitored by a Unit Leader.

REQUIREMENT 10a: Complete the Character Connections for Cooperation. Know, commit to and practice cooperation while conducting your popcorn sale. This needs to be monitored by a Unit Leader.
