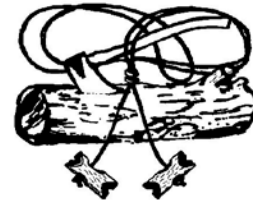

Wood Badge for the 21st Century is a team-based, advanced leadership training program. Wood Badge combines the best of Scouting traditions with contemporary leadership concepts recognized in leading business and governmental organizations and relevant to our movement.

Wood Badge is for all leaders: Cub Scout, Boy Scout, Venturing, and Varsity Scout Leaders, as well as district and council volunteers and professionals.

Each Scouter invited to attend a Wood Badge course must be a registered member of the Boy Scouts of America, and must have completed "Basic Training" for whatever Scouting position they hold. The Annual Medical and Health form is also required of all participants.

Basic Wood Badge Course Information

- The Fee for the course is \$250 and includes all meals, program materials, insurance, administrative costs, tee shirt and recognition items. A \$75.00 deposit is required. There is a \$25 discount if paid in full by March 3, 2012.
- Wood Badge courses are limited to 48 participants – *register early to secure a spot in the course you choose.*
- Both weekends will begin FRIDAY morning at 8:00am and end SUNDAY at 5:00pm. You must attend all sessions, both weekends
